*From the Pastor’s Desk . . .*

*“To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under heaven.”*

*Ecclesiastes 3:1*

As a youth I remember these words as part of a song called “Turn, Turn, Turn” by the rock group “The Byrds”. Based on the text from Ecclesiastes 3 the song went on:

*a time to be born, and a time to die;  
a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what was planted; . . .*

The Biblical words, as well as the song, remind us that change is a constant in our lives and that everything has its place in due time.

As we look to the summer months of July and August, we note that there is a time and purpose for all things, even if for some we don’t understand right away. Some things are clear.

For example, our youth group has scheduled an exciting service opportunity where they will go to Watertown, NY to run Vacation Bible School at a Salvation Army center there, as well as help with their soup kitchen and other community service opportunities. We have the opportunity to help support their mission trip. On Sunday, June 12 at 5:00 pm the youth will host a spaghetti dinner at church to help raise funds for their trip. Tickets are \$5 and a free will offering may be taken. Perhaps it is the season and time to help support our youth in mission!

Speaking of times and seasons, every year in mid-July we host our own Vacation Bible School for children of the church and community. From July 13 – 17 children will learn about Jesus from “Gadget’s Garage”. There is still time for children to register and teen and adult volunteer helpers and leaders are most welcome. Perhaps it is the time and season to support our children in Christian Education!

As the song noted, some times and seasons are bittersweet. For many years now Jen & Will Zipf and children Zach and Hannah have been active in our congregational life. In fact, Jen has directed our Vacation Bible School and she and Will have taught Sunday School and been involved in many other areas of our congregational life. Unfortunately a new job in Maryland means that the time has come for them to leave us and go forth and be a blessing to another congregation.

Fortunately, we will have several occasions to wish the Zipf's "Farewell and Godspeed." On Saturday, July 18 at 5:00 pm Kathleen and Bill Pearson have offered their home in Churchville for a social gathering and an opportunity to informally say our farewells. A formal "Farewell and Godspeed" will be held their last day with us, appropriately VBS Sunday, June 29 at the 9:30 am service. There is a time and season to give thanks for the blessing of their lives here at Advent, but also to release them to be a blessing to others!

In Ecclesiastes 3:3 we're told that there is "a time to break down and a time to build up". As most are aware for about 45 years the lower parking lot has gradually been breaking down, and for 25 years the upper one. Now has come the time and season to "build up". We hope in August to have the lots reconstructed and repaved. It will cost about \$27,000 (the low bid of four) to do the job, not a small sum in this economy. But God is good and His people are generous. Already we have \$ 14,775, 55% of the total cost of the project. Our thanks goes out to all who have responded in ways great or small. Some things can no longer be put off and just have to be done now. There is a season . . . a time . . .!

In many and various ways we must deal with the constants of change in our lives, be it summer service time, worship formats, individuals moving, tasks and challenges to be done. But let us never forget that we need not fear the changes for we have as Lord "Jesus Christ (who) is the same yesterday and today and forever" (Hebrews 13:8). With Him we know all will work for well.
